

Library Scavenger Hunt

Turn a trip to the library into a sensational summer scavenger hunt! This activity encourages kids to explore new topics, discover cool facts, and fall in love with reading—all while having fun. Use a list of creative prompts and clues and have the kids find books that match. It's part learning, part adventure, and all-around awesome.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- 🥑 🛛 Library card
- 🥑 Scavenger hunt list
- Pen or pencil to check off items
- Reusable library bag for all your book finds





HOW TO DO IT:

- 1. Visit your local library.
- 2. Give each child a scavenger hunt list (or make it a team effort).
- 3. Read the clues together, like "Find a book with a dragon" or "Find a book by an author whose name starts with S."
- 4. Explore the shelves and help kids navigate different sections (picture books, nonfiction, graphic novels, etc.).
- 5. Check off items as they're found—and celebrate each discovery!
- 6. Let kids flip through the books to find a few they want to read.
- 7. Check out the books, and maybe even sign up for the library's summer reading program.
- 8. Head home and read together!

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
